Features

The Rabbit Up comes in 4 sizes that are easily recognisable by their great colours, yellow for size 1, blue for size 2, anthracite grey for size 3 and silver for size 4. The Rabbit Up has many great features to accommodate children from approximately 1 year up to 18 years of age. It is designed with slots in the centre bar for mounting the accessories, depending on the needs of the child.



Stander and Mobile stander

The Rabbit Up not only meets a wide range of standing needs but also offers its users the freedom and opportunity to explore using the two optional driving wheels, giving additional independence to the child.



Angle adjustable centre bar

The Rabbit Up has two simple, easy to use angle adjustment options: fixed positions and stepless spindle. This makes transfer easier and helps obtain the best possible position for standing and propelling the driving wheels.



Quick release wheels

The two driving wheels are equipped with quick release for easy mounting and dismounting. The wheels are available in a variety of sizes from 22" up to 36" so you can find the perfect fit for the child.



Camber angling
